Main Topics of TELFOR:

Telecommunications Policy and Services, Telecommunications Networks, Radio Communications, Communications Systems, Signal Processing, Optical Communications, Applied Electromagnetics, Applied Electronics, Multimedia, Software Tools and Applications, and other fields related to Information and Communication Technology.

The work of TELFOR is organized through: plenary sessions with invited papers or lectures, several tenths of authors' sessions from the defined program fields, undergraduate students' sessions, special technical and development presentations of the leading international and domestic telecommunications companies and societies, seminars and tutorials for young engineers and students, exhibition of the communications hardware, software, equipment, systems and services, commercial presentations of the companies and their products, thematic debates, panel discussions on current issues, social meetings, etc.

There are no registration/participation fees for authors and individual participants.

The activities of the companies and seminars are to be paid separately.

September 21, 2010, is the deadline for submitting the complete papers.

Telecommunications Forum TELFOR is the IEEE co-organized and co-supported event. TELFOR is organized for the 18th time as a regional annual meeting of those professionals working in the broad fields of Telecommunications and Information Technologies. The participants are mostly telecommunications engineers, but also the economists, jurists, managers, governmental officials, students, researchers, operators, service providers and others. TELFOR is the forum in which all relevant aspects of Telecommunications and IT are discussed: subjects of technical nature, development, regulatory and economics matters, education, equipment, services and systems operation.

TELFOR regularly has a high number of participants, both individuals and companies. Several previous TELFORs were attended by around 2000 registered individual participants from all telecommunications' segments. Typically, between 200 and 300 thoroughly reviewed scientific and expert papers with 400-600 authors were presented each year, published in the TELFOR CD Proceedings and posted at www.telfor.rs, in English or Serbian languages. Different levels and characters of presentations are accepted: research and scientific results, new ideas, valuable conclusions from practice, state of the art and survey conclusions.

In order to further expand TELFOR's impact and infuence, organizers recently started publishing the TELFOR Jornal, a new scientific magazine, with electronic and printed versions, to include best TELFOR papers, invited TELFOR papers and other papers invited or submitted for publishing (journal.telfor.rs).

Several dozens of participating companies were in some way involved in TELFOR activities during the last seventeen years, among which there were the greatest international telecommunications companies like Agilent, Alcatel-Lucent, Cisco, Ericsson, HP, Huawey, IBM, Intracom, Juniper, Microsoft, Motorola, Rohde&Schwarz, Siemens, etc., together with their local partners, as well as around 50 other domestic and international supporting organizations.
