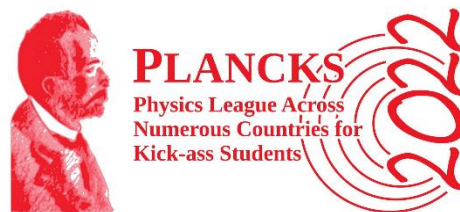


# PLANCKS Bingo
